Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be

tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.
Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.
